

## Updated Policy Spotlight



#### Continual School Improvement

At Houghton Academy, we are dedicated to ongoing school improvement. We continually and consistently review and revitalize our policies to meet the evolving needs of our student body. As we reflect on each policy, we commit to ensuring it is backed by research-based best practices and contextualized to the unique setting and ministry of Houghton Academy, supporting every student's success.



This year, we are featuring examples of policy updates in this newsletter. Parents and students are advised to frequently access the [Student/Family Handbook](#) when seeking clarification of Academy policies and procedures. Updates are made regularly to this "*living document*" as we seek to continuously improve the academy's operations.

For example, based on exposure to additional research that was brought to our attention on the topic of **Progressive Discipline Plans that support Restorative Justice**, we updated our [Discipline Policy](#) accordingly, thanks to those who brought the additional research to our attention.

Today, we announce the update to our [Valedictorian / Salutatorian Eligibility Policy](#).

The benefits of the updated Val/Sal Policy include:

- Encouraging students to strive for excellence not only in their academic coursework but also in leadership and extracurricular involvement.
- Research shows that students who engage in leadership roles and challenging coursework are more likely to develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and collaboration skills, which are essential for success in higher education and future careers (Kuh, 2008). Leadership experiences in high school also foster personal growth, responsibility, and a sense of contribution to the community (Dugan & Komives, 2007).
- Additionally, students who take on rigorous coursework, such as university-level classes, are better prepared for the academic demands of college. Studies indicate that students who complete advanced courses in high school have higher college completion rates and perform better in their first year of postsecondary education (Adelman, 2006).
- By broadening the criteria for Valedictorian and Salutatorian beyond GPA alone, this policy ensures that top students are recognized for their academic achievement and their holistic contributions to the school and readiness for future success.
