
What is the Annual Fund?

- Gifts to the Annual Fund are critical to the Academy's annual operating budget.
- It is the money we spend first during the current fiscal year to ensure every student has the best educational experience possible.
- We ask every parent, alumni, staff, community member, volunteer, and faculty member to contribute to the Annual Fund and help propel the Academy from an excellent school to an exceptional school.

What does the Annual Fund support?

- Hire, retain, and professionally develop skilled faculty
 and staff
- Enhance and maintain campus infrastructure (buildings, sports fields, etc...)
- Expand technology and innovation, including updated computers and classroom software.
- Support the athletics, arts, and music programs (uniforms, equipment, etc...)
- Provide financial assistance to students whose families demonstrate need and would otherwise not be able to attend HA, allowing for an increasingly diverse population.

Can I restrict my gift to a certain program or area of student life?



- The Annual Fund supports the school's current annual operating budget, so unrestricted gifts are extremely important to the success of a balanced budget.
- When you give an unrestricted gift, you give where it is most needed. Unrestricted donations help in all aspects of student life, including keeping the student-faculty ratio 8 to 1, enhancing our sports and fine arts programs, improving campus technologies, and hiring/retaining the best teachers.

Updated Policy Spotlight



Continual School Improvement

At Houghton Academy, we are dedicated to ongoing school improvement. We consistently revitalize our policies to meet the evolving needs of our student body. As we systematically review each policy, we commit to ensuring it is backed by research-based best practices, supporting every student's success.

This year, we will feature examples of the policy updates in this newsletter. Parents and students are advised to frequently access the <u>Student/Family Handbook</u> when seeking clarification of Academy policies and procedures.

Our newly updated <u>Progressive Discipline Policy</u> is a prime example of this effort, reflecting our commitment to a *restorative justice* approach. This approach prioritizes student growth, accountability, and the healing of the school community. Rather than focusing solely on punishment, we aim to address the underlying causes of behaviors, encourage personal reflection, and provide opportunities for making amends. Research shows that restorative justice and progressive discipline foster safer school environments, reduce repeat offenses, and improve long-term student outcomes (González, 2012; Gregory, Clawson, Davis, & Gerewitz, 2016).

Key Benefits for Students:

• **Promotes Accountability**: Students learn to take responsibility for their actions, fostering personal growth and maturity.

- Encourages Reflection: The system helps students reflect on their behavior and understand its impact on others.
- Builds Skills for Future Success: Students develop problem-solving and conflictresolution skills that benefit their academic and social lives.
- Reduces Recidivism: A tiered system allows students to correct their behavior without the immediate imposition of harsh penalties (American Psychological Association, 2020).
- **Supports Mental and Emotional Health**: By focusing on repairing harm rather than punitive measures, students feel more connected to the school community and experience improved well-being (Thorsborne & Blood, 2013).

Our updated policy consists of three progressive levels, each offering increased support and consequences (e.g., students who incur a Level 2 violation may also be placed on probation).

Additionally, we have implemented *policy infraction fees* as part of this update. Research suggests that introducing reasonable financial consequences can encourage students and parents to take school policies more seriously, reinforcing accountability (Thaler & Sunstein, 2008). These fees are thoughtfully designed to be fair, ensuring they do not disproportionately impact students from lower-income families. Paired with restorative practices, these fees aim to create positive behavior change rather than solely punitive measures.

- On the morning of October 24, Houghton Academy will administer standardized tests from the SAT Suite to students in grades 8-12. This will not affect students; grades, but the scores will help identify their literacy and fluency in English, Mathematics, and college readiness.
